General Labor

Performs general manual labor tasks including loading, unloading, lifting, and moving materials. Assists a variety of functions with manual labor tasks as needed. May require a high school diploma. Typically reports to a supervisor or manager. Possesses a moderate understanding of general aspects of the job. Works under the close direction of senior personnel in the functional area. May require 0-1 year of general work experience.

Fiber Optic Crew

Fiber optic linemen use construction equipment, such as plows, trenchers, borers and winches to dig trenches, either to lay underground cable or to install poles. Linemen perform maintenance and repair work, examine lines and use electrical equipment to test for damage.

Traffic Control – Flaggers

Performs traffic control and flagging activities as needed; follows safety rules and regulations on all work zone and flagging sites, including placing signs, barricades, traffic cones and other warning devices.

Traffic Control Supervisor

Supervises tasks related to vehicular, pedestrian and construction traffic control operations related to road, bridge and highway heavy construction projects. Responsible for implementing and overseeing traffic control operations, lane closures, road closures, setting signs and devices, per MHT's and in compliance with local, state and federal rules and regulations. Operates a variety of vehicles, hand tools and power tools. May clean sites, and remove waste materials. Will work near traffic and interact regularly with the public.

Project Manager

Plan, budget, oversee and document all aspects of the specific project you are working on. Project managers may work closely with upper management to make sure that the scope and direction of each project is on schedule, as well as other departments for support.
