SUMMARY / OBJECTIVE:

The Apprentice will spend time training under other Plumbing Professionals in order to develop a well-rounded knowledge of plumbing and piping systems. The Apprentice will perform entry level general plumbing duties as required with supervision.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

These duties are not listed in any order of priority but will be weighted for performance management purposes.

1. Promote safety as the core value at TATRO.
2. Develop an understanding of plumbing trade basics such as fixtures, drain waste & vent systems, water distribution systems, and piping & fittings.
3. Act as a helper with the assembly, installation, and repair of pipes, fittings, and fixtures by performing duties as directed by the supervisor.
4. Maintain equipment, tools and company vehicles in clean and good working condition.
5. Ensure job site cleanliness and organization through all phases of the service process.
6. Prepare work sites as directed.
7. Perform general labor tasks such as sweeping, cleaning, delivering, loading and unloading, etc.
8. Other duties as required.

REQUIRED SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE / QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of 18 years old.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Ability to pass a pre-employment drug test.
- Basic mathematical skills.
- Basic computer/tablet skills, including Microsoft Office products and email services.
- Must have a willingness to learn.
- Must be willing to travel when needed.
- General construction knowledge is preferred but not required.

COMPENSATION:

\$14.00/hour. Time and One-Half, over 40 hrs/wk. Bonuses are given based on individual performance and overall company success.

PER DIEM:

Additional compensation to be provided through project subsistence or per diem, should overnight travel or work be required.

WORKING HOURS:

Under normal circumstances, this position requires a minimum of 40-45 hours per week. At times you may be asked to work in excess of the 45 hours per week and occasionally, weekend work may be required. Normal work hours are from 7:00 – 5:00 Monday thru Thursday, with Friday being 7:00 – ???

PERSONAL TIME:

According to Company policy, Ten (10) days of personal time are available after one (1) year of employment through four (4) years. Eighteen (18) days prorated during your fourth (4th) year through Seventh (7th) year of employment, and Twenty-Four (24) days are prorated per year thereafter.

HOLIDAYS:

After 90 days of employment, you become eligible for Six (6) paid holidays per year: New Years' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

UNIFORMS:

You will be treated as a field employee, receiving:

- 5 Shirts each Spring
- 5 Long Sleeve Shirts each Spring
- 1 Jacket per year
- 6 Pairs of Pants per Year (3 Winter/3 Summer)
- Hard Hat, Safety Glasses, Hi-Viz vest as needed
