In addition to ensuring that safety rules are followed on the site at all times, the Foreman will work with the Superintendent to meet production and work schedules.

The Foreman reports to the Superintendent, and will work closely with the Project Managers, Equipment Manager, and Materials Manager.

Primary Functions

- Work alongside Field crewmembers on any task that needs to be completed for the good of the project
- Coordinate daily tasks according to priorities and plans, making changes when necessary due to weather, supply, delivery and personnel while communicating with the Superintendent
- Maximize efficiency and productivity of crewmembers
- Delegate project specific responsibilities to crew members and contractors
- Train, manage, and mentor field labors
- Coordinate activities with contractor and other subcontractors onsite
- Emphasize safe use of tools, machinery, and equipment while providing training on PPE safety gear and procedures
- Work with Superintendent to understand project budgets and work quality standards for the job site
- Resolve conflicts or miscommunications quickly and professionally
- Regularly report project status to Superintendent, Project Manager, Inspectors/Engineers and other officials, as required
