Construction Associate

The Construction Associate performs a wide range of construction tasks. This can be in general construction or more specialized roles when required. Construction Associates prepare the site for construction, perform labor functions, and assist with essential tasks around the project. Construction Associates oversee a wide range of tasks throughout the day and week. Associates will take ownership of their tasks, ensure they are being completed appropriately in a timely manner, and continue their tasks without constant direct guidance from the supervisor.

Roles

- Willingness to undertake training if necessary.
- Assisting tradesmen and machine operators on construction projects.
- Cleaning the site and discarding waste.
- Cleaning off site as needed.
- Assist and operate bigger tools when necessary.
- Follow instructions from construction project managers and supervisors.
- Follow all health and safety regulations.
- Assist Safety Manager in watching for safety violations and best practices

Responsibilities

- Prepping construction sites, materials, and tools.
- Loading and unloading of materials, tools, and equipment.
- Removing debris, garbage, and dangerous materials from sites.
- Assembling and breaking down barricades, temporary structures, and scaffolding.
- Assisting subcontractors as required.
- Assisting with transport and operation of heavy machinery and equipment.
- Regulating traffic and erecting traffic signs.
- Digging holes, tunnels, and shafts.
- Prepare and apply construction materials to build structures or fill gaps.
- Perform preventative small tool maintenance.
- Assisting with measuring, leveling, and spacing.
